
PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

Turn around, don't drown when encountering flooded roads. Most flood deaths occur in vehicles.

Be especially cautious at night when it is harder to recognize the dangers of flooding.

In hilly terrain there are hundreds of low water crossings which are potentially dangerous in heavy rain. Do not attempt to cross flooded roads. Find an alternate route.

The National Weather Service has issued Flash Flood Warnings at Camp Mystic on 91 different days in the last 25 years. As of 2009**, there have been 35 days where a Flash Flood Warning was issued at Camp Mystic. As you can see from the graph, most of those warnings amounted to a minimal rise.

**Historical data for NWS alerts goes back as far as 2000. Historical data for the daily max water rise at the flood gage in Hunt, TX is available back as far as 2009.


Looking at the flood data for the three dates with the largest rise in that timespan, you can see how each flood progresses differently.


April 15, 2010: 10ft rise in about 2.75 hours
October 15, 2018: 10ft rise in about 13.25 hours
July 4, 2025: 30ft rise in about 2.75 hours

When looking at other Flash Flood Warnings, many are almost identical to the one that was issued at 1:14am on July 4, 2025. For example, an almost identical alert was issued 4 years prior and only resulted in 1.4 feet of rise in Hunt, TX.

Additionally, the weather forecast did not predict anywhere close to a 500-year rain event.

In summary, it is difficult to judge in real time whether a rainstorm poses an actual flood risk. It would not be reasonable to expect an immediate evacuation based on a simple Flash Flood Warning.
